SUN TOLERANT HOSTA

Hosta thrive in partial shade; however, some Hosta are more sun tolerant than others when grown with enough moisture. The varieties listed below have the potential to tolerate $\frac{3}{4}$ to full sun, but they may still show some burning in hot, dry conditions. In sunny locations, expect that blue Hosta may look greener, green varieties may look lighter, and gold varieties may look brighter.

SLUG RESISTANT HOSTA

Hosta with thick or corrugated leaves, or a vase shape, tend to be more slug resistant. Avoid mulching around Hosta once the canopy is formed, since mulch can provide slugs a home.
