

Lingonberry

Plant size is 16-24", two plants needed to produce fruit

Sun exposure: This perennial shrub prefers full sun

Soil: Soil pH on the acid side of 4.5-5.5. Loves a well-drained soil, 2" layer of mulch or wood chips prevents moisture loss

Planting: Plant as soon as soil is thawed to an 8" depth
Bury the plant slightly above the root ball. Allow two feet between plants.

Fertilizing: Do not fertilize until new growth begins. Apply a fertilizer formulated for acid-loving plants.

Watering: Water when the top inch of soil begins to feel dry making certain to provide enough water to reach an 8" depth. Allow soil to dry between watering.

Harvesting: Flowers appear in late spring and fruit can be harvested in mid-summer
