

## **Chicago Hardy Figs**

It is normal for this plant to die back in our colder climate but fear not; new spring growth will produce fruit again. Plants reach an average height of 3'.

**Sun exposure:** Full sun with some protection from the north wind

Loamy, well drained, soil with a pH range of 6.0-6.5.

Makes an excellent container plant.

**Fertilizing:** Fertilize in early summer

**Watering:** Water when soil is dry to a depth of three inches.

**Harvesting:** Fruit forms during summer - harvest in the fall

Pruning is not usually needed, as this plant will die back in

Winter care: the winter, though some light pruning may be necessary if the
