

Chicago Hardy Figs

It is normal for this plant to die back in our colder climate but fear not; new spring growth will produce fruit again. Plants reach an average height of 3'.

Sun exposure: Full sun with some protection from the north wind

Soil: Loamy, well drained, soil with a pH range of 6.0-6.5.
Makes an excellent container plant.

Fertilizing: Fertilize in early summer

Watering: Water when soil is dry to a depth of three inches.

Harvesting: Fruit forms during summer - harvest in the fall

Winter care: Pruning is not usually needed, as this plant will die back in the winter, though some light pruning may be necessary if the plant is protected from the brutal north wind.
